The [West Heidelberg Community Legal Service \(WHCLS\)](#) is currently seeking volunteer law clerks for their successful clerkship program.

Law clerks assist the WHCLS team with all aspects of their important community law practice, including research, administration, reception and client support work. It's a structured and supervised law clerkship and you will learn how to deliver legal assistance to clients with multiple and complex needs.

There are currently three vacancies available. Each position involves one day per week of work on either Monday, Wednesday or Friday ideally for at least a 12 month period.

WHCLS is a not-for-profit organisation that provides a range of free legal services to the local community. It is part of [Banyule Community Health](#). Many previous WHCLS law clerks have gone on to secure employment in diverse, law-related fields as a direct result of their clerkship.
